Degree Recipient Employment or Post-Graduation Study Rate

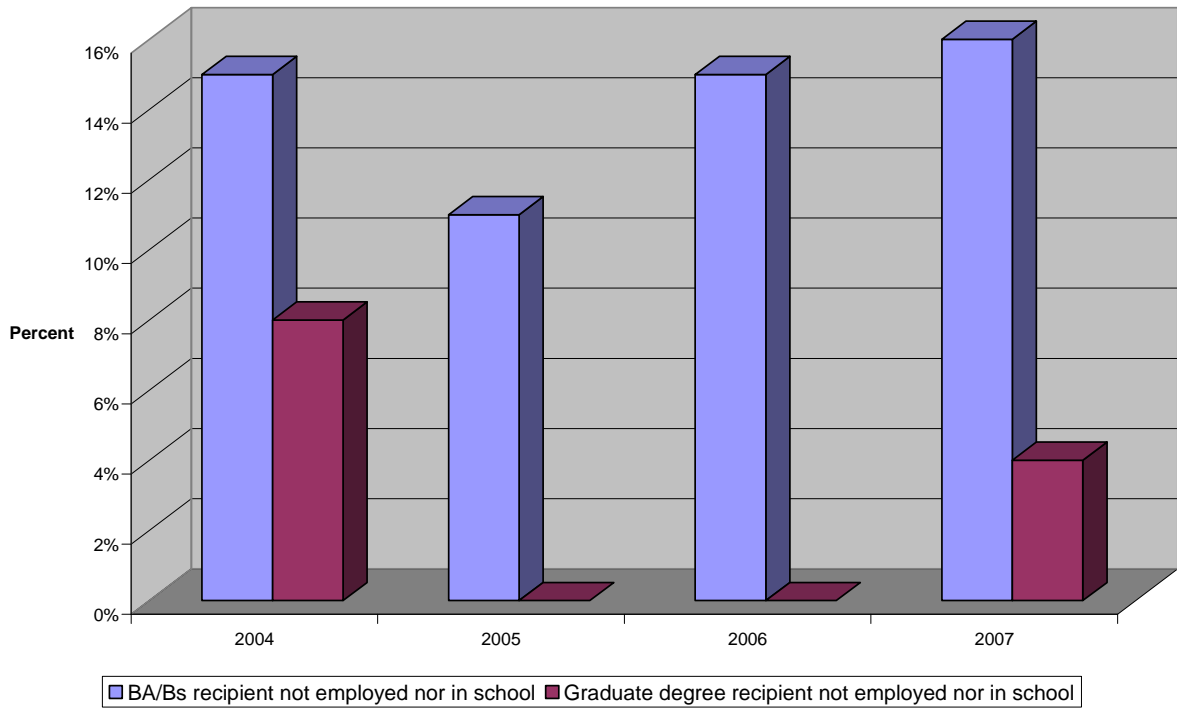

Previous Program for First Time Freshmen

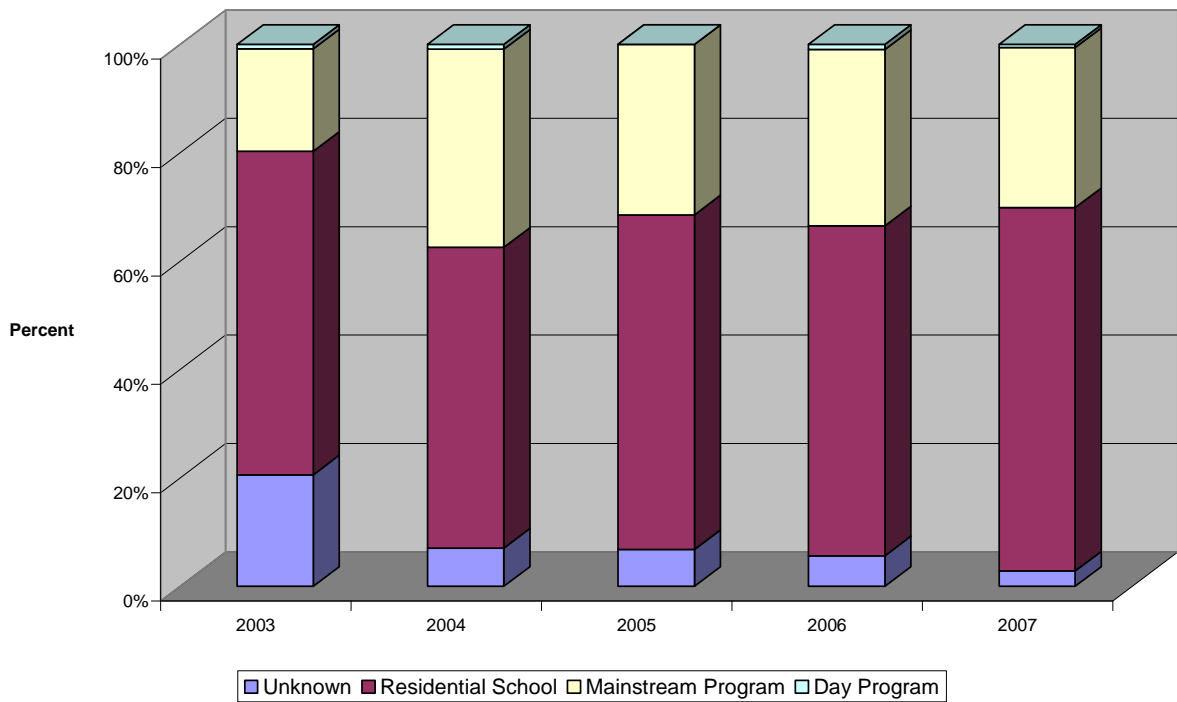
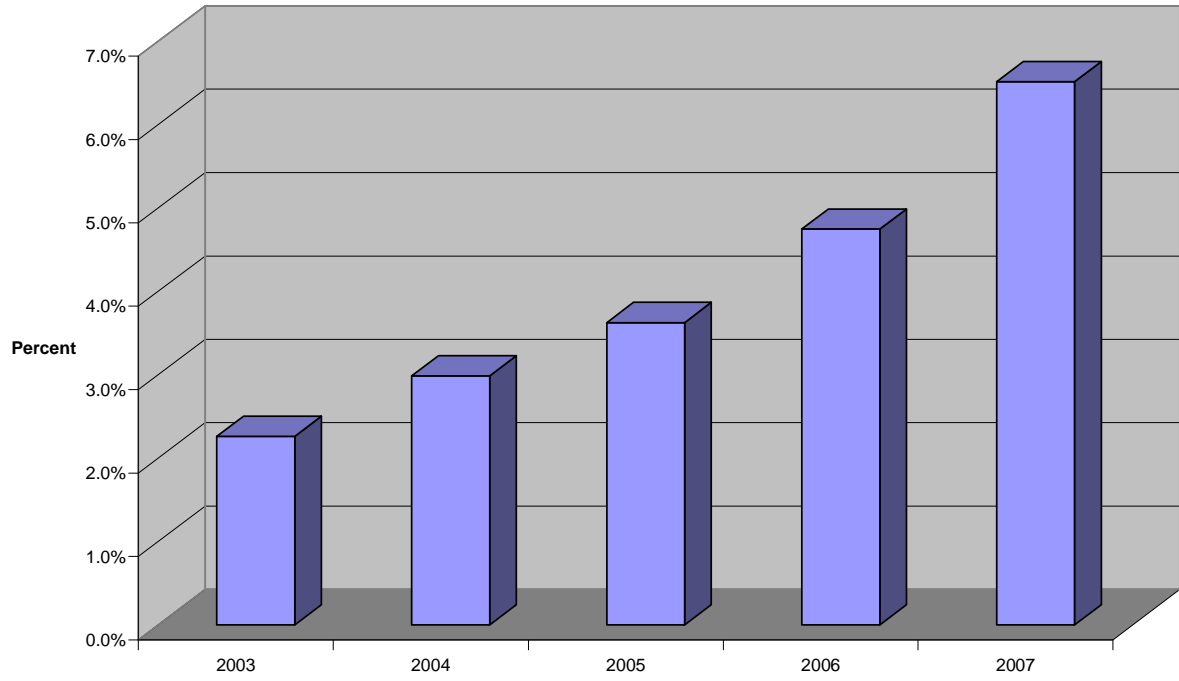

Percent of Deaf or Hard of Hearing Employees by Category

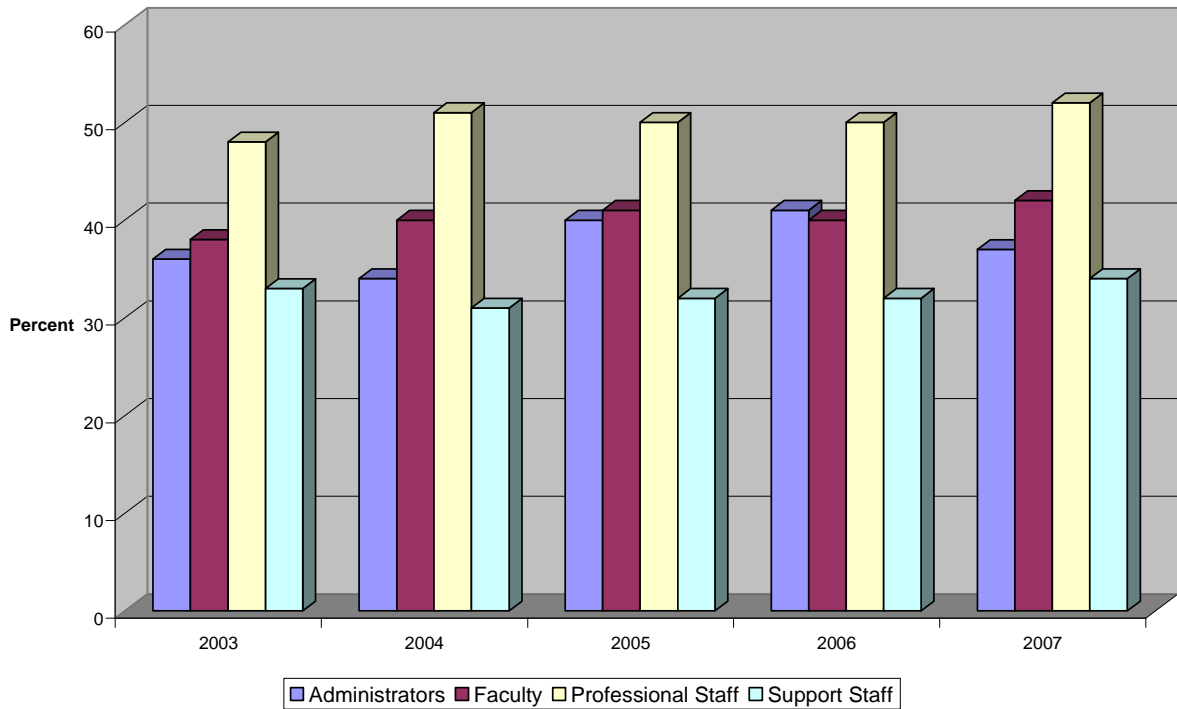

Percent of Traditionally Underrepresented Groups by Employee Category

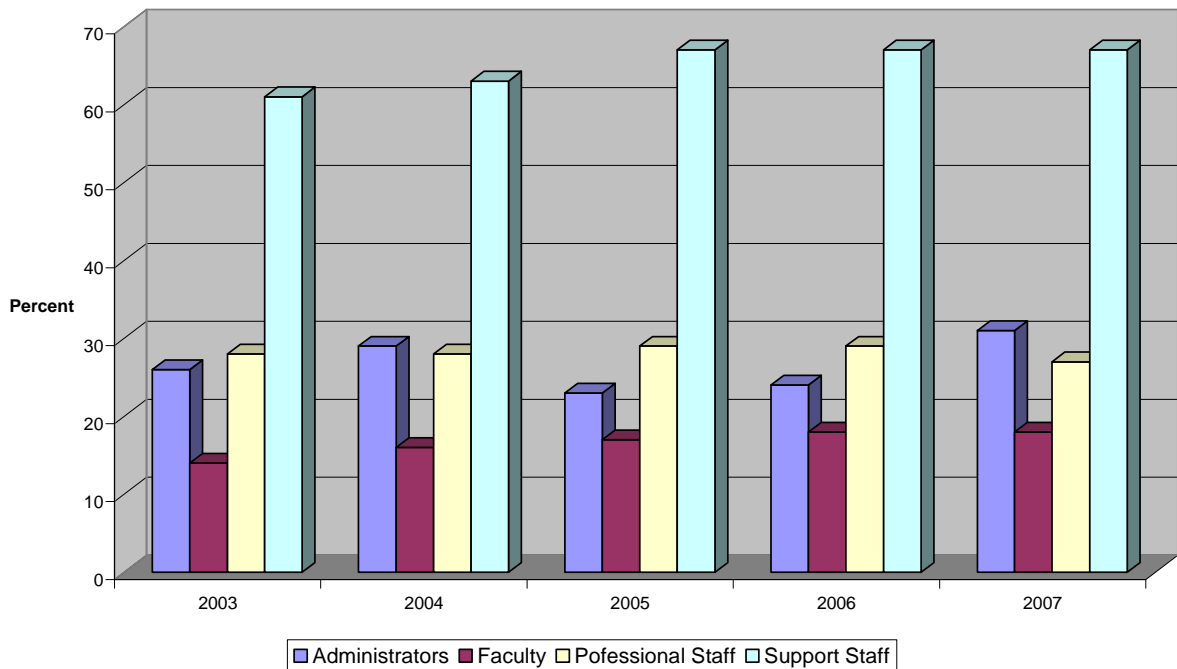

Regular Faculty by Highest Completed Degree

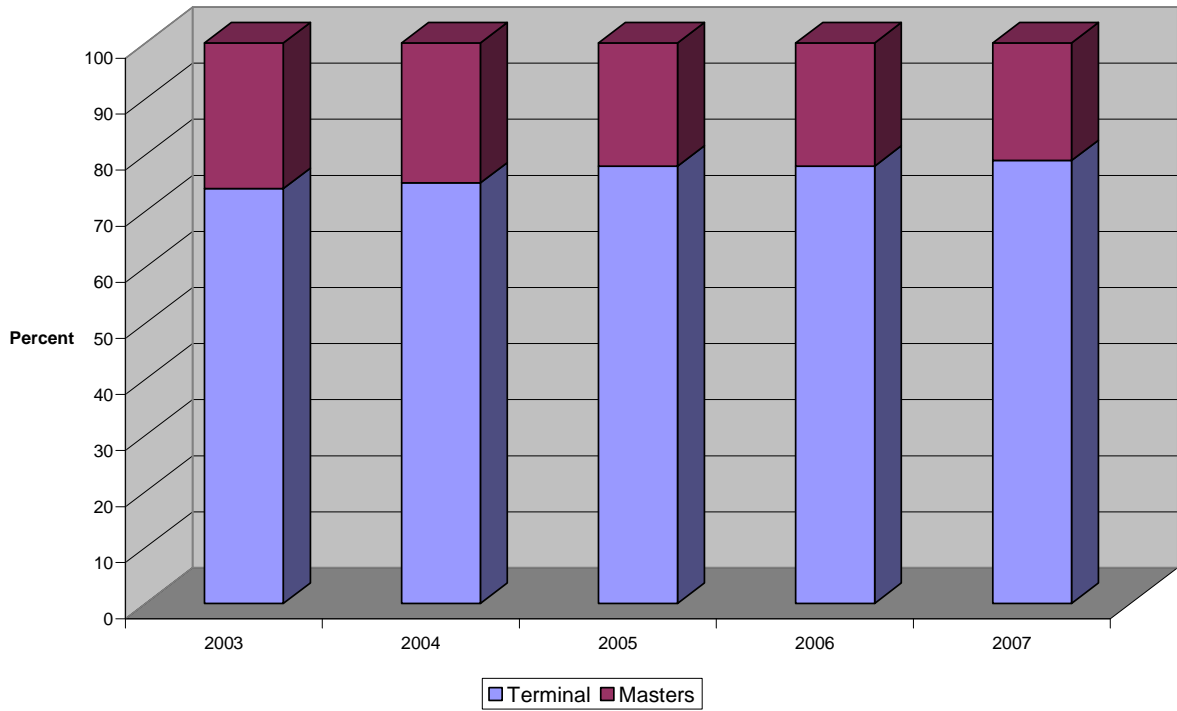

Tenure Status of Faculty

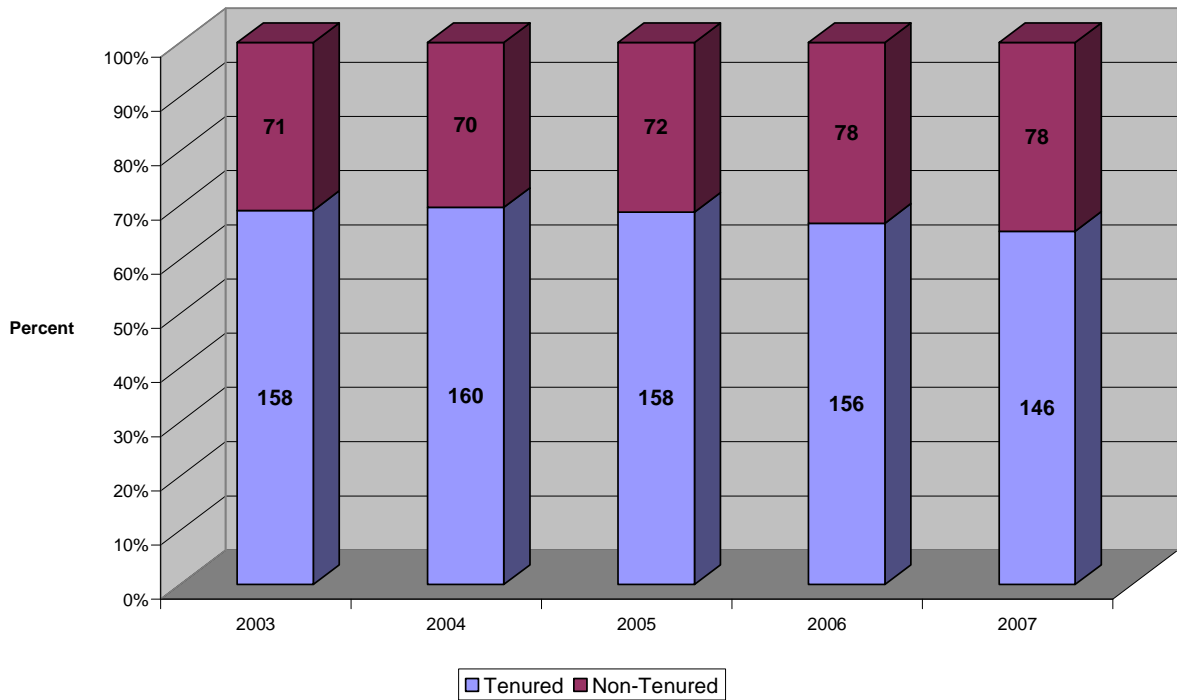

Regular and Full Time Temporary Faculty by Rank

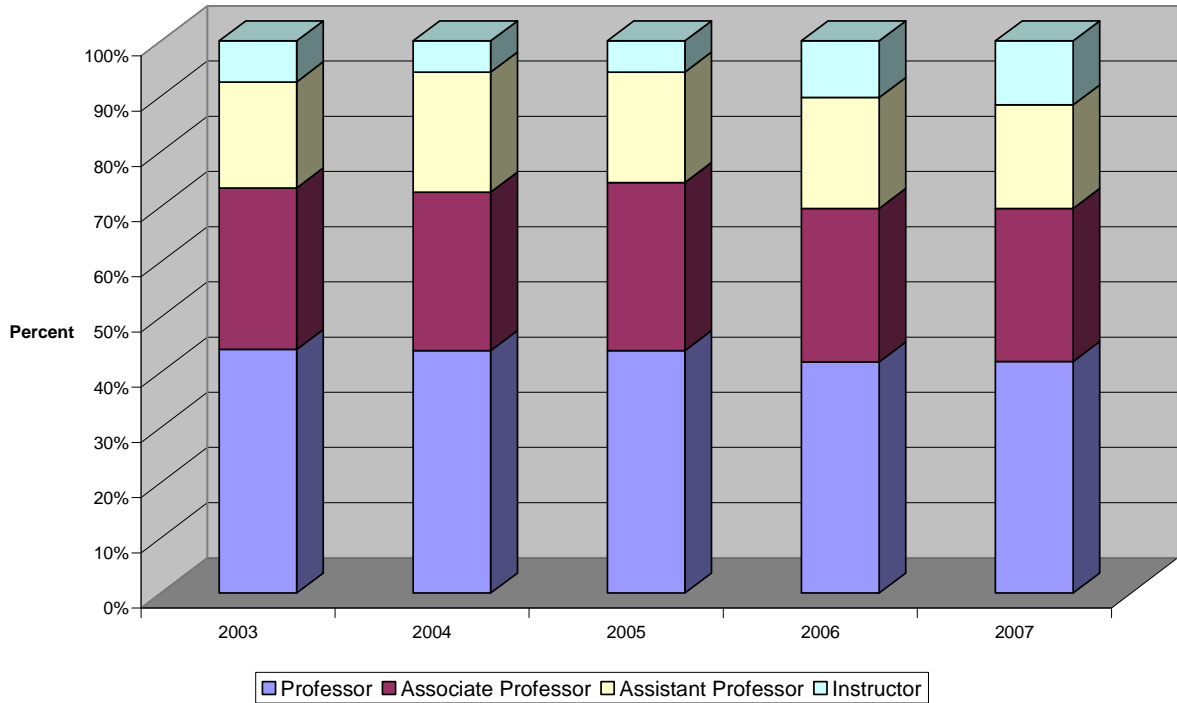

Average Salaries of Full Time Faculty (9 months)

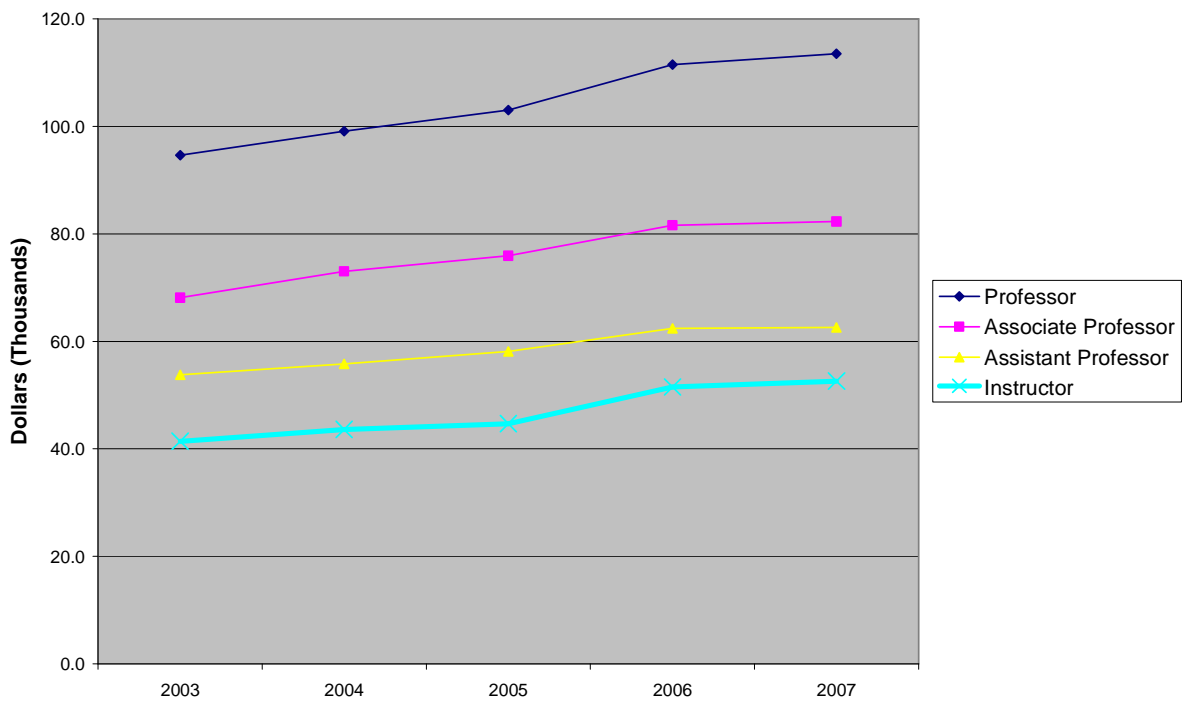
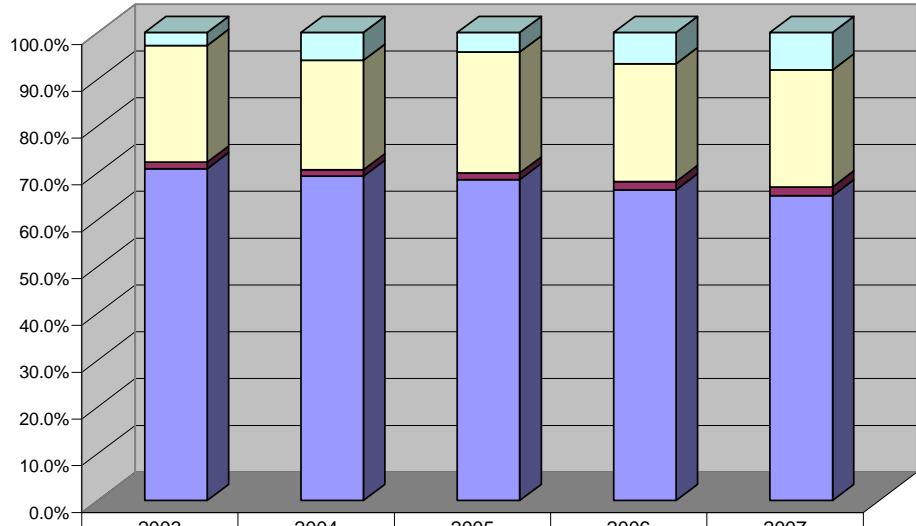

Percentage of Faculty Involved in Funded Research

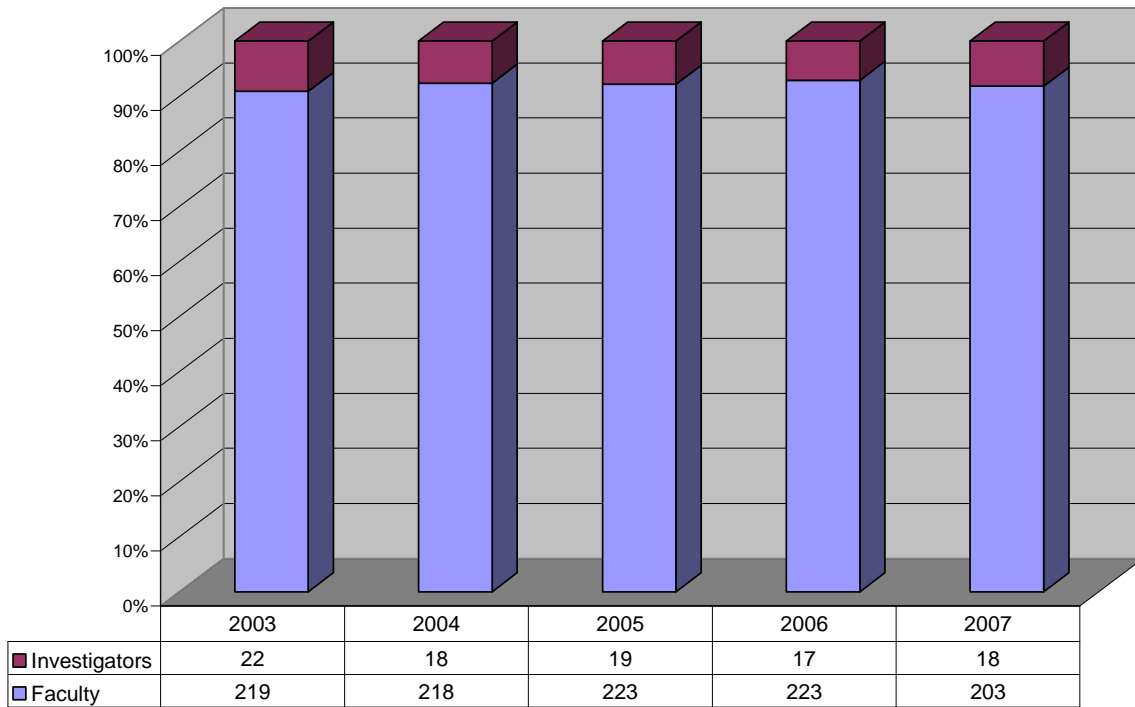

Faculty and Staff Projects by Type of Content

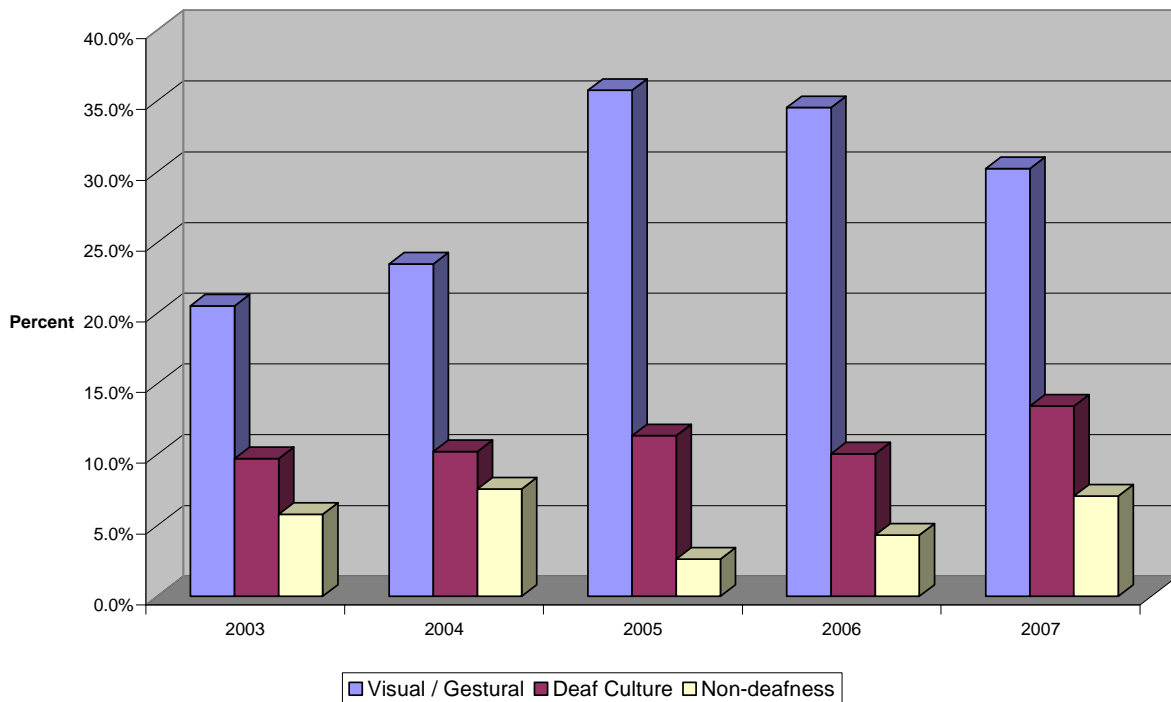

Ratio of Unique Investigators to Funded Research Projects

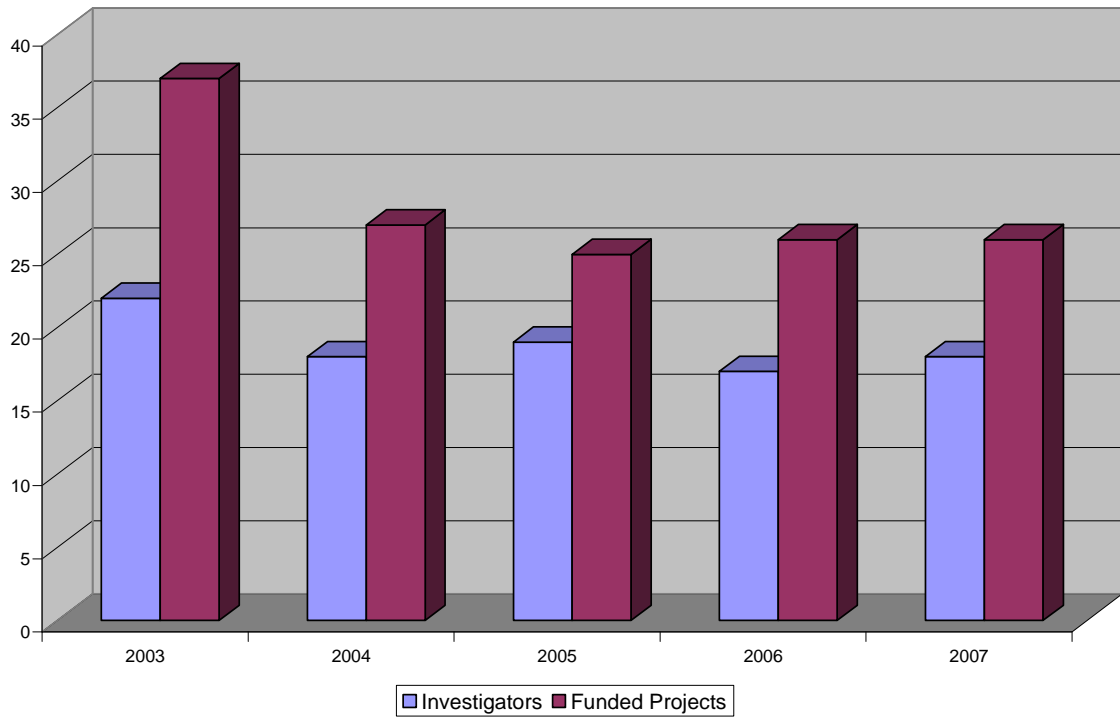
